## America's Physician Groups

#### **Overview of Primary Care First**

- 5year voluntary model commencing Jan 2021.
- Risk Based
- Three Options: General; SIP; Both
- Application deadline Jan 22, 2020; Nonbinding

## America's Physician Groups

#### PCF General Model Payment Model

- 1. Population Based Payment (four levels, based on HCC scores)
- 2. Flat visit fee; \$40.82
- 3. "Bonus" based on regional benchmarks of hospital utilization

## **Practice Eligibility**

- Minimum of 125 attributed beneficiaries
- 70% of practice revenue must be primary care
- 2016 CEHRT
- Advance primary care capabilities

#### America's Physician Groups

#### Seriously III Population (SIP)

- High cost, high need; top 2% most acute
- Comp model
  - Initial visit payment (\$325)
  - Monthly population-based payment (\$275)
  - Flat visit fee (\$40.82)
  - Quality Bonus
- High touch capabilities

- 5 year voluntary model
- Risk Based
- Qualifies as APM
- Original Medicare; Open Network
